The following table demonstrates that, across the whole school, the gap in progress between Non-Pupil Premium and Pupil Premium children is -0.16. This has closed from -0.34 in 2014 and is particularly pleasing given that rates of progress have increased across the school for ALL pupils and are now, on average, ABOVE expected rates per academic year.

***Cherry Orchard Primary is using PP Funding to enhance rates of progress for all pupils, whilst those disadvantaged pupils continue to accelerate their progress rates and narrow the gap on other pupils in the school.***
